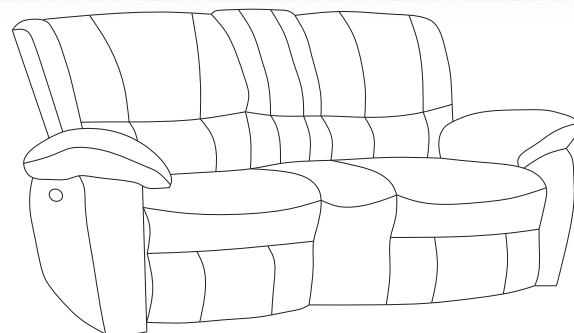

- Ⓓ Right back cushion

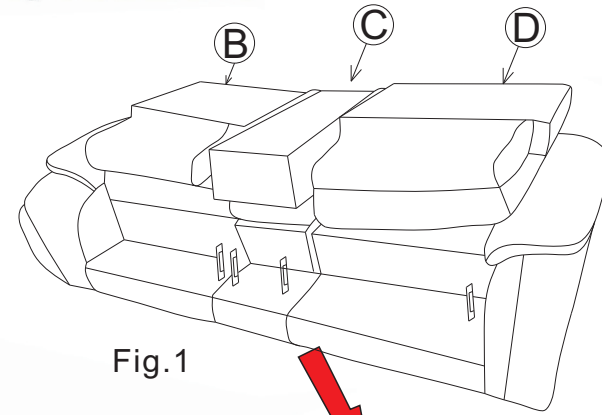

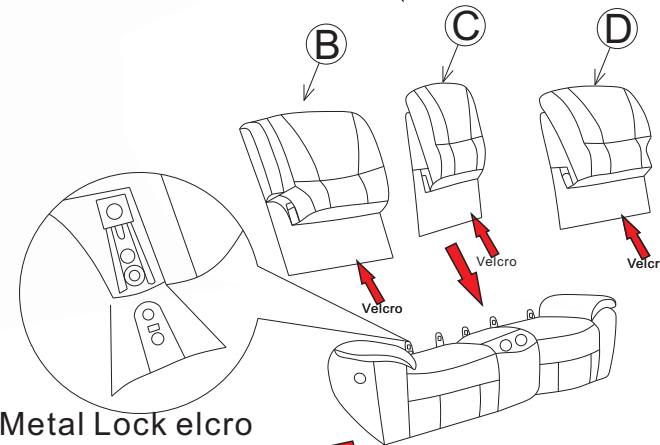
